

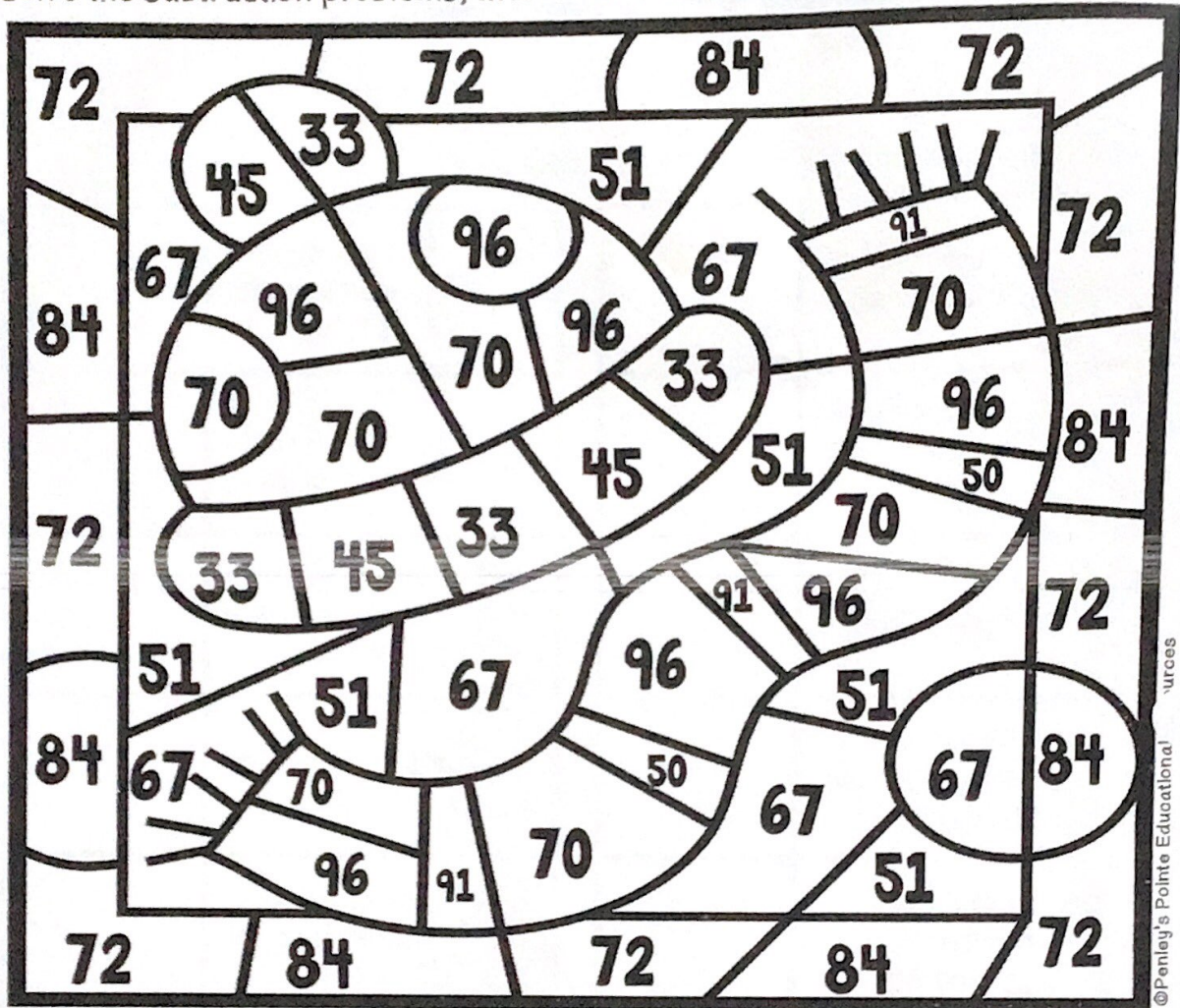

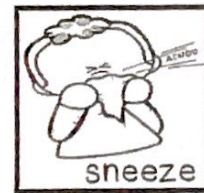

Some animals hibernate in winter. These animals sleep all winter! Their body temperature drops and their hearts slow down. In the summer and fall, they eat to store fat to help them stay warm in the cold weather. 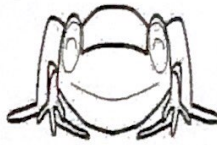
